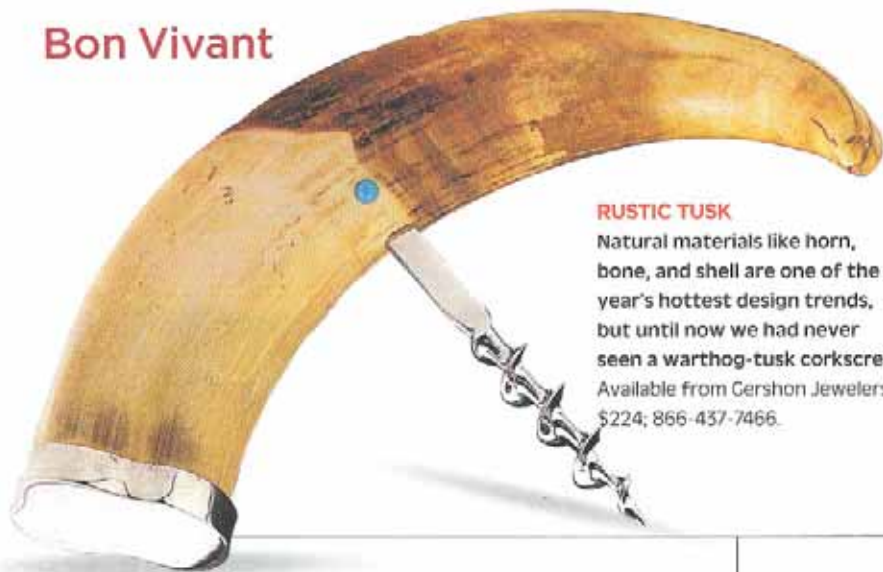

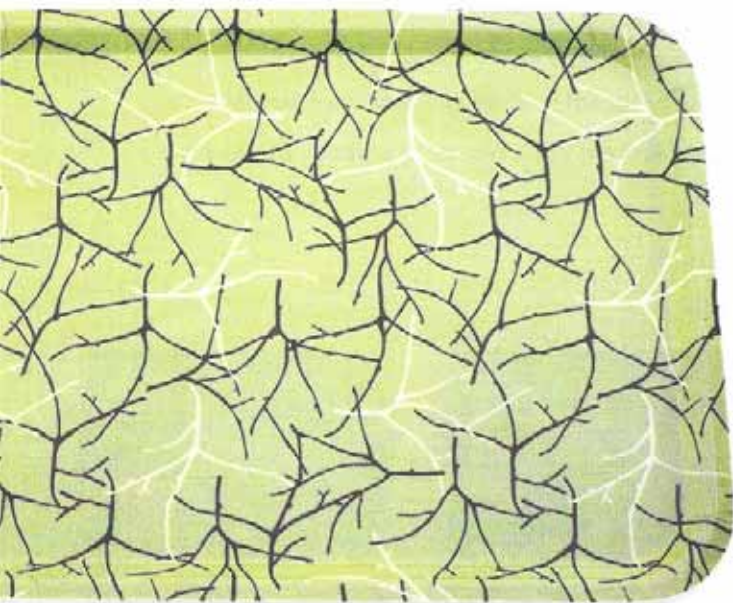


RUSTIC TUSK
